Section A: Directed Writing*{35 marks}**{Time suggested : 45 minutes}*

You are a reporter with a local newspaper. You visited the site of a minor earthquake near a hill resort and interviewed some witnesses and victims of the earthquake. Use the notes below about the incident to write your **newspaper report**.

Damages and Losses

- Rock stumbled down- road
- Uprooted trees
- Homes –covered-mud and debris
- Farms and orchards- demolished

Casualties

- Three buried alive
- Four injured-hospitalised
- An elderly –perished

Factors aggravating the earthquake

- Volcanic eruption- neighbouring countries
- Soil erosion

Actions taken

- MERCY Malaysia- give medical aids
- NGO (Non-Government Organisation)
- Food, temporary shelters and clothes

When writing the newspaper report, you should remember to:

- Provide a suitable **title** for your report
- State **the place and day** of the incident
- Use **all** the notes given
- Include **a comment** and **a hope** given by the victims/witnesses
